Report from Mike, the owner of the shed that was hit.

Here is how I found the meteorite. I woke up the morning of Friday June 27 at 0815 in the morning to let (my dogs out). I sat down on my patio chair with my black coffee and observed the two doors on my Rubbermaid tractor shed laying on the grass. The shed was over 20 years old and three of the four pins holding the door were broken off. The inside of the doors were puddled with water from a rain storm. I walked over to install the doors back I observed a black rock at the 5 o'clock position laying under the right swing door.

I picked up the rock thinking my youngest female German Shepherd found it. I didn't think too much about it and slung it next to the storage shed so I would not hit it with my zero turn lawn mower. I picked the black rock up noticed it was heavy and strange looking but didn't think it was anything different about it. I contacted my best friend in Indiana I speak with daily and told him what happened. His wife stated there was a meteor shower in Georgia and you need to find it and see if a magnet will stick to it. I located the stone and it stuck to a magnet. Tina my friend's wife said Michael that's a meteorite. My friend asked did you see if it hit the doors. I walked outside and checked the left swing door on the shed I noticed a gouge and an impact strike on the door. I took numerous pictures with a tape measure and weighed the stone at work. The stone weighed 173 grams.

A private buyer offered to purchase it (...). The purchaser also took the left hand swing door off my shed showing proof of the meteorite strike.
